We currently operate six, Grade 8 to Grade 10 schools, in a collaborative initiative with the PMC and our funding partners. Our six schools serve about 1100 students and 330 student alumni. 100% of the students coming to iTeach Schools are from under-resourced and difficult backgrounds. The lack of access to good education and opportunities creates a huge achievement gap. The secondary grades are the last lap of intervention for these students, and most likely, the only chance we have left to level the playing field between them and their high-income peers. Education is one sure means for these students to break the circle of poverty.

In the Academic Year 2019-20, we are looking at starting more schools, and are looking for an exceptional person to join as our Curriculum Associate to develop expertise in Curriculum Design & Implementation – towards making our students learning at school truly purposeful, real world and contextual.

Responsibilities

The Curriculum Associate will work with the Curriculum Manager on the overall research and development of the school's curriculum. They will provide assistance to School Leaders and Teachers in its effective implementation and implementing processes for constant improvement. Given that iTeach Schools is a young start-up, we are looking for people who will be eager to design and create the most effective systems and processes, combining researched best practices with their own contextual innovation.
